Each year, more than two thousand people gather to walk and run in support of CURE at **Lauren's Run & Picnic**, in memory of two special girls named Lauren. The event truly brings the community together, with families, individuals, schools, and companies forming teams to support the fight to cure childhood cancer. Beginning with a 5k and 2k run/walk, the race is followed by a family-friendly picnic, complete with food, a live DJ, inflatables, carnival games, arts and crafts, and so much more. The CURE Picnic is a reunion opportunity for our families and a day of fun for all!



The inaugural Lauren's Run was held on May 23, 1993, and supported the research of Dr. Michael Jensen, a leader in the field of immunotherapy treatment for children. Made possible by the early years of Lauren's Run fundraising, his CAR-t cell therapy research has now become a frontline treatment that is saving lives. Since that first event, Lauren's Run has raised more than \$4.8 million in the fight against childhood cancer.


